REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

2022

For admission, all candidates must have the following documents, in an envelope folder, on which candidates must write their full name and their father's initial:

- Application form-available at the admissions office
- Birth certificate- certified copy
- Marriage certificate or any other document that states the name change-certified copy
- Baccalaureate degree or equivalent-certified copy
- Bachelor's degree and academic transcript-certified copy
- Master's degree or further studies degree and academic transcript (except for graduates earlier than 2003)-certified copy
- Curriculum vitae;
- List of scientific works already published;
- Written proposal of a research theme according to their scientific coordinator's field of expertise together with grounded justification of the proposed research theme;
- Extensive bibliography regarding the proposed research theme supporting the oral presentation;
- Linguistic skills certificate-uncertified copy-(minimum standard B2 level);
- For foreign citizens- Romanian linguistic skills certificate;
- The proof of registry fee payment (registry fee is 300 lei and payment must be paid in the account RO 03 RNCB 0076010452620060, Cod fiscal 4505502. The proof of payment must be on candidate's name).
- **All employees of the University of Bucharest are not subject to tax payment.**

All certified copies must be notary certified.

Candidates who have studied abroad must have the certified copy of their degree as well as its certification by the National Council for Attesting Titles, Diplomas and Certificates within the Ministry of National Education and Scientific Research
