



Defence and Dialogue in Eastern Europe (#DDEE) is open for registrations!

Defence and Dialogue in Eastern Europe (DDEE) gathers a series of events organized along one week on two dimensions: theoretical (forum) and practical (simulation of NATO decision-making process and study visits). DDEE aims to raise awareness on the defence and security threats that are now developing in Eastern Europe.

The events will take place from **July 31 to August 5, 2017** at **JW Marriott Grand Hotel in Bucharest, Romania** and will involve over 200 participants from all over the world with different backgrounds and from different generations.

DDEE will start with a **Forum**, where senior experts covering defence and security areas will debate on current topics of interest for the Eastern European neighborhood (**Countering Disinformation, Enhanced Forward Presence, Cyber Security, Ballistic Missile Defence, Projecting Stability, NATO–EU Relations**). The forum will settle the ground for debate on NATO’s current agenda by keynote speeches and panel sessions. The forum will emphasize the importance of NATO today and will raise awareness on the NATO’s role in the 21st century, its importance to national security and the role it plays in international relations.

After the forum a more practical event (**Model NATO simulation**) dedicated to the younger generation will be organized, where youth from different countries will have the opportunity to better understand NATO values expressed through its decision-making process. This simulation also marks a special anniversary edition of the EADSociety’s flagship event *Model NATO Youth Summit*.

DDEE represents a fantastic opportunity for young people to consolidate different skills and it is an important step on the formation of young professionals’ professional career.
